



Communication Milestones at 5-6 years

- Engages in full conversation
- Uses complicated reasoning
- Conversational sentences are complex and grammatically correct
- Tells or retells a story with sequential plot and cohesion
- Engages in cooperative play, such as making group decisions, assigning roles, and playing fairly
- Uses conditional phrases, such as “could have been” or “will be”
- Understands and produces rhymes
- Describes objects, people, and places by their attributes
- By their 7th birthday, articulation should resemble adult-speech

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
